The differing disciplines of the two brothers-in-law allow them to embrace many facets of gardening. Together, and with an extended team of gardeners, they have designed and worked on a variety of gardens, both large and small. Over the years, Peter and Tom have had the good fortune to work in Ray Mears' garden. It was during this period that their ideas for sustainable gardens evolved. So, when designing their Hampton Court exhibit, it was important that the garden would follow this ideal and be able to replenish itself year on year and prosper with minimal attention.

Their chosen name 'Natural Shade' is the essence of the garden. All materials are both natural and, wherever possible, locally sourced. To this affect, a Sussex woodsman has employed his skills to handcraft an intricate fence as part of the design. Plants have been carefully selected to include both the wild and cultivated.

The result is a sheltered, tranquil cocoon of dappled shade with plenty to entertain the senses and to encourage wildlife.
